Two Types of Presentations to Consider

- 1) Verbal Podium Presentation.** We are looking for presentations that showcase projects, process improvements, or research from your organization that show how you promote excellence in stroke care and could be of interest to the broader stroke community in the state of Oregon. This presentation may also include a poster or a PowerPoint of something recently presented at a national conference, yet not to the OSN audience. The Verbal Podium Presentations will be held ***Friday, September 22nd***. Anyone/organization with expertise in this area is invited to submit their work. Podium presentations will be approximately 20 minutes in length.
- 2) Professional Poster Display.** If you have a poster that aligns with the conference theme "***Promoting Excellence in Stroke Care***", we encourage you to submit your work for presentation in the Professional Poster Display. This may include stroke-related projects, research, or process improvement learnings and outcomes. The poster can be one you have presented in a national forum, or a new poster designed for this conference.

All abstract submissions will be reviewed and selected by the Conference Planning Committee.

We look forward to the generation of some great sharing of ideas and stroke work being done in Oregon.
