

Cincinnati Stroke Scale

Facial Droop (ask patient to smile or show their teeth)

Arm Drift (Ask patient to close eyes and hold both arms out with palms up)

Speech (Ask patient to say “The sky is blue in Cincinnati”)

Time is crucial!

Normal

Both sides should move equal

Both arms move the same

Patient uses correct words no slurring

About 3 hours before treatment won't help

Glasgow Coma Scale

Eye opening

Spontaneous	4
In response to speech	3
In response to pain	2
None	1

Best Verbal Response

Oriented Conversation	5
Confused conversation	4
Inappropriate words	3
Incomprehensible sounds	2
Incomprehensible sounds	1
None	

Best Motor Response

Obeys Commands	6
Localizes Pain	5
Withdraws to pain	4
Abnormal Flexion	3
Abnormal Extensions	2
None	1

Score: 14-15 Mild Dysfunction

Score 11-13 Moderate to Severe dysfunction

Score 10 or less is severe dysfunction
